- Cogmed for working memory & attention
- DIR/ Floortime based treatments
- SOS based treatments for picky eaters & problem feeders

- Sensory integration/ processing based clinic treatments & home programs

Funding options:

- Medicare – CDM, GP Mental Health Care plans, Autism or Better Start Disability plans
- FaHCSIA –government for autism and Better Start
- NDIS provider
- Private Health

How to refer:

- Use appropriate item numbers to refer under a Medicare plan.
- Use a standard referral letter for children not coming under a plan.
- Parents phone direct to make an appointment.

Note: The standard process is 2 x assessment sessions, 1 x parent feedback / goal-setting session followed by treatment as negotiated with parents.
